Thessaloniki, since its foundation in 315 BC., has always been a cosmopolitan center, a crossroad of people and cultures. So is her gastronomy, a mixture of the traditions of Christian, Muslim, Armenian and Jewish populations, that coexisted in the city, with the gastronomy of the Greek refugees from Asia Minor, who arrived in the city in the early 20th century.



About the tour:

The city is located in the center of the fertile Macedonian flatland, with a very busy harbor. Subsequently, its market has always been full of fresh local agricultural, livestock and sea products, as well as exotic food raw materials.

This educational and entertaining activity is the perfect experience for those who love food & drinks and want to get familiar with the city's past and present through the flavors and tastes that give Thessaloniki its unique gastronomic character
